

Jury Information

On behalf of Honorable Greg Nicholas, presiding Circuit Judge, Honorable Martha E. Williams, Circuit Judge and Lisa McSwain, Circuit Clerk, we welcome each one that has been chosen for jury service. It is one of the highest duties of citizenship.

All those that have been summoned for jury service should report on the day required, to the large courtroom, 3rd floor at the courthouse. You should arrive in time to be checked in. Please complete ALL information on your jury summons, prior to your arrival. The courtroom is normally open at 8:00 a.m. to begin the check in process. Court begins promptly at 9:00 a.m.

The judge presiding at each session of court will go over what you can expect to experience during your time of jury service. Jury service is scheduled to be for a one week period. Every person that serves will be issued a check for each day of service and be given a certificate of service for your employer.

The court schedules eight weeks of criminal jury trials and four weeks of civil jury trials each year.

The judges and their staff, along with the circuit clerk and her staff, will do all that is possible to make your jury service as pleasant and enjoyable as possible.
